

**2025 Huron County Democratic Party Scholarship Essay Contest:
Technical, vocational, professional licensing option - \$1000
scholarship**

We are changing our scholarship program this 2024-25 school year: There will be two scholarships, 1.) for those heading to college or university worth \$1500, and 2.) for those heading for technical, vocational or professional licensing training. This application is for the technical, vocational, professional licensing option for \$1000.

Our scholarship will be awarded based on an essay contest, the winner of which will receive a scholarship of \$1000. The contest is open to any 2025 Huron County graduating Senior, whether enrolled in a public/private school, completing the GED, or home schooled. The scholarship amount will be paid directly to the technical, vocational or licensing institution of the student's choice, and may be paid in multiple amounts until the full \$1000 is used. There will be a scholarship award presentation at the student's awards night.

Please attach a **double-spaced essay** of not less than 600 words nor more than 750 words (about two pages) on this topic:

Describe **three** Huron County voter-elected and taxpayer funded jobs/positions.

1. What are the duties and responsibilities of each position?
2. What is the elected term of service?
3. How does each office holder interact with other local government positions – think coordination, supervision, review, audit?
4. As a Huron County resident, how does the elected office-holder of this position interact with you and/or your family?

Note: The essays will be judged “blind”. The judges will not know the name, gender or school of the essay writer. These essays will be judged by a separate panel of judges than the essays for the college/university scholarship. The winning essay will be offered to local newspapers for publication, and posted at <hurondems.org>. The student will be asked to record a reading of her/his essay as well.
